

2006 Operational Plan – Strategic Goals

1. To continue to raise the academic achievement of all students.

- To raise achievement by:
 - Identifying students (including Maori students) who are at risk of not achieving
 - To raise the level of literacy and numeracy
 - To successfully implement the National Certificate of Educational Achievement
 - To monitor student attendance especially where it is a barrier to learning
 - To raise academic achievement by having standardised achievement based assessment
 - To improve information technology opportunities.
 - To engage in assessment best practice through the implementation of the AtoL professional development programme,

2. To provide a high standard of teaching.

- To continue the redevelopment of the teacher appraisal process.
- To provide professional development to all staff as identified by the appraisal process.
- To provide professional development to all staff as identified as a school wide focus.
- To refine systems for data based reviews of teaching and learning and behaviour.
- To develop a long term plan for professional development.

3. To monitor and control expenditure.

- To prepare and monitor a budget which meets the financial restrictions.

4. To monitor and raise the achievement of Maori students

- To maintain a close liaison with the local Maori community.
- To promote tikanga Maori and kaupapa Maori
- To support the reintroduction and rejuvenation of kapa haka.
- To follow the objectives for the plan for promotion of achievement of Maori students
- To provide professional development to staff regarding strategies to improve Maori achievement
